Check-in and Parade Unit Management - Report time is 8:30 am (8:30 am to 1 pm)

Volunteers work with parade staff to check in, line up, keep on time, manage and check out the various bands, floats, etc. that will be in the parade.

Human Wall and Parade Walk - Report time is 9 am (9 am to 1 pm)

Volunteers walk up and down the parade course before and during the parade.

Leprechaun Race for the Pot O' Gold Course Mgmt. - Report time is 9 am (9 am to 1 pm)

Volunteers work with race staff to place, manage and remove race material on the running course (along Congress Avenue).

Canned Food Donation Management - Report time is 9 am (9 am to 3 pm)

As you stand on the Parade course, Spectators will hand you their canned food donations which you will give to the Official Donation Vehicles that drive by during the Parade.

Crowd Control - Report time is 8:30 am (8:30 am to 2 pm)

You must be 21 years of age or older to volunteer for this position. Voluntary Waiver and Release Agreement: This Voluntary Waiver and Release Agreement ("Agreement") is hereby executed by the undersigned, or if the undersigned is under the age of 18 years, then the undersigned's parent or legal guardian (together with any heir, successor, representative or assign, collectively as "Volunteer") in favor and for the sole and exclusive benefit of the Organizers (as defined herein). In connection with Volunteer's involvement in volunteering for the St. Patrick's Day Parade of Central Texas, Inc. ("Company") or in any other event which may relate to Company or which may take place in connection with the Company including, without limitation, the St. Patrick's Day Parade (the "Event") to be held March 17-18, 2006, Volunteer hereby certifies, warrants, represents, agrees and covenants to Company and any of the respective Event sponsors, beneficiaries, producers, service providers or promoters (individually and collectively, together with their respective affiliates, officers, employees, partners, shareholders, members, sponsors, contractors, agents, successors and assigns, the "Organizers") that he/she is: (1) free from any mental or physical condition, ailment or injury (medical or otherwise) which would, in and of itself or in conjunction with any other circumstance, including but not limited to those activities associated with the event, (i) impair, prevent or prohibit volunteer from engaging in such event activities or (ii) be affected, aggravated or worsen in any way as a result, directly or indirectly, of volunteer's involvement in such event; (2) aware that the parade course is approximately one mile long and extends down Congress Avenue and 4th Street and acknowledges that it is her/his responsibility to understand the risks and determine whether he or she is fit and sufficiently trained to participate in the Event; (3) aware and agrees that any medical or other services rendered to him/her or at the insistence of any of the organizers and not an admission of liability to provide or continue to provide any such services and are not a waiver by any said parties of any rights hereunder; (4) of sound mind and body and not under the influence of alcohol or any illicit or prescription drug or medication which may in any way impair volunteer's ability to enter into this agreement, fully understand the respective intent and meaning of all of the terms and provisions hereof and to participate in the event; (5) entering into this waiver and release agreement voluntarily, by volunteer's own free will, act and deed, without any undue influence from the organizers or any other third party.

Volunteer agrees that he/she derives a material benefit from the event and/or volunteer's involvement therein. By execution of this agreement, volunteer expressly and unconditionally assumes all risks and dangers known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, and relating or incidental to volunteer's involvement in the event and any activity associated therewith. Volunteer hereby releases, forever discharges and holds harmless the organizers from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses arising out of or relating to volunteer's involvement in the event and all activities associated therewith. Volunteer further agrees that the Organizers shall have the right to record, broadcast and otherwise exploit in any and all media throughout the world Volunteer's activity/performance in the Event and to use Volunteer's name, likeness, voice and biographical information in connection therewith. If any provision of this Agreement shall for any reason be held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision hereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid or unenforceable provision were omitted. The waiver and release granted by volunteer hereunder is legally binding and shall be considered irrevocable. Volunteer agrees that the organizers may rely upon this agreement to the fullest extent permissible at law or in equity.
